



## Downloading eBooks onto an iOS device

### Actions before downloading an eBook from dawsonera:



Register for an Adobe ID at <https://accounts.adobe.com/>



Download Digital Editions from the App store

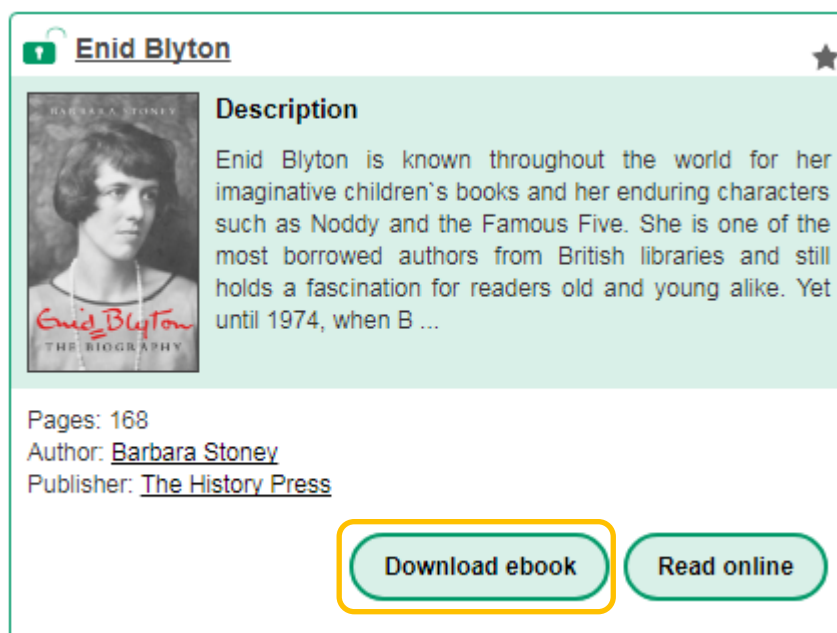

Download BlueFire Reader from the App store

### Downloading an ebook on dawsonera from an iOS device

1. To download an eBook, log into dawsonera on the iOS device, search for the required title and click the download button



2. Choose the length of the download from the drop down menu and click download.

### Download ebook

Like a traditional library, our ebooks are loaned to you for a limited time.

To continue reading after your loan has expired you will need to download again.

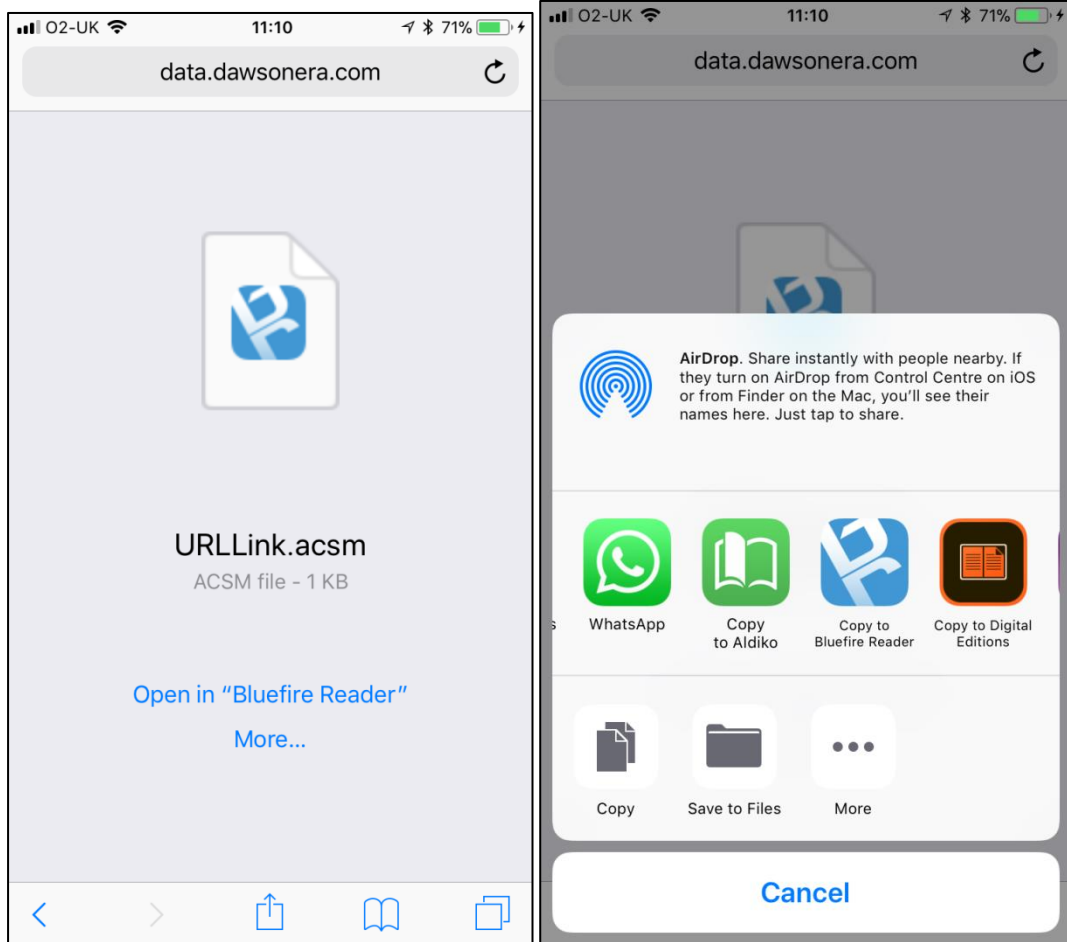

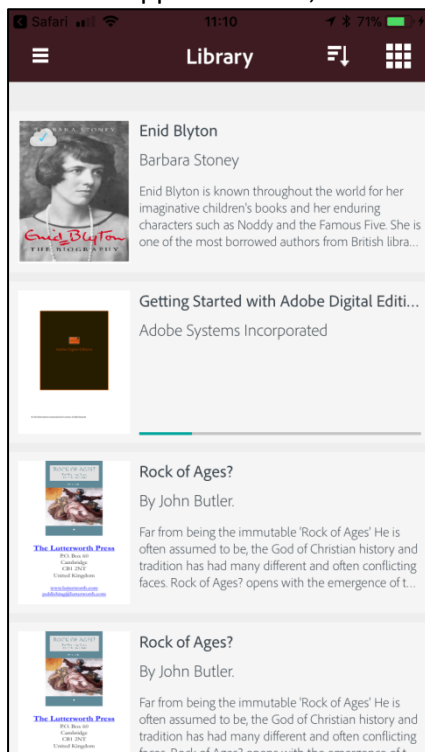

4. Clicking on the iPhone/iPad users link will open a new window in Safari – click open in BlueFire Reader/Adobe Digital Editions. Alternatively, you can click on “more” and select a different app, i.e. Adobe Digital Editions.
