### 3. Searching

#### a. Quick Search

Enter single search term(s) or phrase (with words enclosed in quotation marks "..."). Boolean operators (AND, OR and NOT) may be used.

Quick Search allows searching in all fields or in any one of four fields



TIP: To search for a phrase, put the phrase in quotation marks to return results only for that phrase, rather than for each individual word. For example, enter "special education."

#### b. Advanced Search

Use a combination of search fields to limit your search. Boolean operators may be used.





## 6. Playlists


