


### Introduction


If you have already kept a record of your papers in your EndNote Library, you can now upload all your publications into your ResearcherID profile in Web of Science. You will first need to export the references in RefMan (RIS) Export format (see section A). Then upload the RIS file in ResearcherID to add the references (see section B). Note: Only documents that are indexed in Web of Science will have Times Cited information.

### A) Exporting Citations from EndNote in RIS Format


Step 1: Open your EndNote Library. Under the styles formatting dropdown box, click on "Select Another Style".




Step 2: Type in “refman” in the search box and press the Enter key. Then select “RefMan (RIS) Export” and click “Choose”.



Step 3: Next, select the references you wish to export. Hold the Ctrl or Shift Key to select more than one reference. Then go to File > Export.



Step 4: Select the Output Style as “RefMan (RIS) Export and save as “Text File”. Give a filename to the exported file. Then click Save. Note: Remember the filename and the location.



## B) Adding Publications from EndNote RIS File

**WEB OF SCIENCE™**

**NOTICE:** Your IP address is not in the *Web of Science* subscription database. These options will not be available.

**Search Web of Science**  
Use this option to search *Web of Science*. Depending on your subscription, this can include articles, books, patents, and more.

**Search Web of Science Core Collection**  
Use this option to search *Web of Science Core Collection*. Depending on your subscription, this includes the world's leading scholarly literature in the sciences, social sciences, arts, and humanities and proceedings of international conferences, symposia, seminars, colloquia, workshops, and conventions.

**Search Web of Science Core Collection Distinct Author Sets**  
Use this option to search *Web of Science Core Collection* for sets of articles written by the same person.

**ENDNOTE™**

**Go to EndNote**  
Use your EndNote account to add articles and manage your ResearcherID publication lists.

**Option 3:**

**Upload RIS file.**

**Upload an RIS file (from EndNote, RefMan or other reference software)**


You can upload an RIS formatted text file. The RIS file format is a tagged format for expressing bibliographic citations.

Step 5: Click on “Browse” and select the RIS file which contains your exported citations. Then click on “Upload File”.

Step 6: If successful, you will be informed of the number of items added to your Publications List. Note: If the item is already in your list, it may not be uploaded. Click on “Return to My Researcher Profile” to check on the updated list of publications.

Step 7: Check that your publications are added correctly, and there are no duplications. To delete items from the list, click on “Manage List”.

Step 8: Select the items you want to delete, and click on “Delete Selected Publications”.
